

What to Bring to Treatment

All clients entering treatment should bring contact information of any outside parties that will need notification of client admission, such as probation, child protection, attorney's, etc.

All clients staying in Park Avenue Center housing should bring the following items to intake:

- One week of comfortable clothing, free of references to drugs/alcohol/violence or a criminal lifestyle. Clothing should provide adequate body coverage.
- Personal care items that are free of alcohol and in non-aerosol containers. Including toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, shampoo, deodorant, feminine hygiene products, etc.
- A 30-day supply of all necessary medical prescriptions, in the original bottle. Lack of medication may delay the intake process.

Clients staying in Park Avenue Center housing should **avoid** bringing the following items:

- Personal items in excess of two bags. Anything considered excessive or non-essential will need to be picked up by a designated friend or family member.
- Large sums of cash or personal items of a high monetary or sentimental value. In the event of an AWOL, property left at Park Avenue Center will be disposed of.
- Electronic devices (working or non-working) including but not limited to cell phones, tablets, laptops, radio/MP3 players, etc. Electronic devices will be surrendered and stored upon intake. In the event of an AWOL, property left at Park Avenue Center will be disposed of.

Clients on methadone should dose prior to admitting on day of arrival.
