

# CLIENTS WITH A SEX OFFENSE

Through a partnership with Hennepin County Department of Community Corrections and Rehabilitation, Park can accept individuals with sexual offense convictions.

## PROGRAM INFORMATION

Park Avenue Center is a licensed substance abuse treatment provider and approved by MN DHS for co-occurring, culturally specific, and medical services modifier rate enhancements. As such, our staff includes licensed addiction counselors, licensed psychologists, licensed mental health therapists, licensed social workers, registered nurses, registered dietitians, and peer recovery specialists. Through our relationship with Kai Shin, we also have physicians and physician assistants on-site who can prescribe and monitor suboxone and mental health medications.

## OUTPATIENT PROGRAMMING

We can accept all clients convicted of sexual offenses in our outpatient programming. The typical schedule is four hours a day, four days a week and decreases over time as clients progress through their treatment plan. If clients struggle, we have the flexibility to increase their participation, including more programming each day and can even include weekend programming.

## FREE OFF-SITE HOUSING

Through a partnership with a local sober house, we can accept and provide housing for clients that do not require broad general public notification regarding their residence. Therefore, we are able to accept clients who are designated at Levels 1 and 2 as well as those who do not have a level designation into our Intensive Outpatient Program with housing through this partnership. Unfortunately, this means we are not able to provide housing for clients designated as Level 3 offenders or have been released from a sexually dangerous civil commitment although they are welcome in our outpatient programs.

## ADMISSIONS
